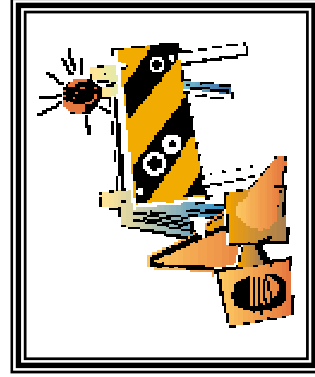
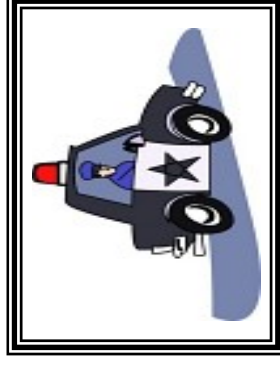


## Cellular on Patrol (COP) Program:
