

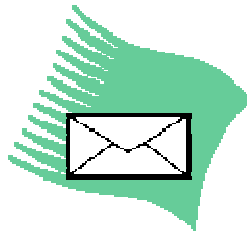

DID YOU KNOW?

Property Owners are Responsible for Maintenance of Sidewalks,
Curbs and Driveways

The sidewalks in front of your home are an extension of your front yard and should be maintained. Sidewalks should be accessible to all your neighbors and fellow community members. To make your neighborhood useable for all, be sure to keep sidewalks free from any obstructions such as mailboxes, basketball hoops, parked cars, trashcans, shrubbery and fences. Keep all trees, shrubs and grass on the premises well trimmed so

they will not overhang the sidewalks and interfere with the pedestrian path. Failure to keep sidewalks clear may result in a fine up to \$500.00 (Code of Ordinances, City of San Antonio, Sec. 29-11, Sec. 6-1 and Sec. 1-5).
